## Plans for 2023/24

### Class arrangements:

The classes for next year are planned with the following year group structure:

Class 1: Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 – Total: 14

Class 2: Year 2, Year 3 and Year 4 – Total: 21

Class 3: Year 5 and Year 6 – Total: 19

When planning classes for each academic year we consider the size and needs of the children in each year group, in addition to the total number of children in each class, as we aim achieve a balance in terms of class sizes across the school. As we have 14 children in our current Year 1 cohort, they will be split across Class 1 and 2 next year when they are in Year 2 and this has been done in consultation with Year 1 parents.

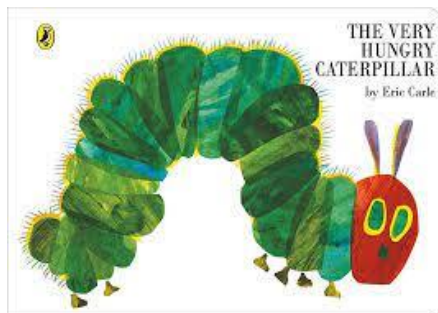
### Staffing:
