Reception

This week, the reception children have been enjoying the story 'We're Going on a Bear Hunt', they made a story map of the main events, made a model of the setting which included bridges and then went on to develop Caspar's idea of using a ship to get across the river which they built and tested outside using a log flume.





The children have been enjoying writing their own stories, based on the class text, 'Stone Age Boy'. In science this week, we have been researching different animal habitats. They all enjoyed the Odd Sock Day on Monday in which they created a collaborative



piece of sock art after a discussion about how to treat each other with kindness and what to do if a friend is feeling sad.



Year 3 and 4

The children are really enjoying Stig of the Dump

– ask your child to tell you about The Snargets and predict what they think might happen next.

In science this week we've been learning about different types of muscles in the human body and how they work. We've also been testing ourselves to use the scientific names for the main bones in the skeleton.

In history, we have begun learning about the changes in prehistoric Britain when the Beaker folk arrived from Europe in search of metal ore!

We enjoyed exploring watercolour paints in Art in our new unit on 'colour and contrast', learning about analogous and complementary colours.

In English, we have started to plan a book review about our class text Freedom. We also managed to perform our acrostic poems to the class. We have also undertaken a science investigation in order to prove or disprove a given hypothesis. We are currently in the process of presenting our data using a scattergraph.
