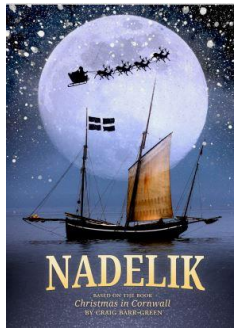




St Austell Verse Speaking Festival
