Reception

This week the children have enjoyed 'Peace at Last' by local author Jill Murphy. They've been learning about how to keep their teeth healthy with good brushing habits and did an experiment to compare the





effects of different drinks on our teeth. They role played a dental surgery, taking in turns to be dentist and patient and a long wait with magazines in the waiting room!!



Year 1 and 2

This week we have been writing directions; creating our own maps of London with some of London's well-known landmarks. In Geography, we have been identifying human features within our locality and around our school. In reading, our focus has been on the setting of 'Daisy and the Trouble with London', through the description of the train station. In Art, we were using a range of textural materials to make collagraph print using crayons to produce the rubbings.



Year 3 and 4 In reading, the children drew a detailed sketch based on the description of the street scene in Chapter Two. They used dictionaries and the I-Pads to research new vocabulary such as, rickshaw and bullock-cart, which they could then include in their picture. In science, the children explored force meters, making sure they first calibrated the scale before measuring the forces needed to pull a basket of books across the table.



Each group recorded their measurements in a simple table and we then collated their results share their work to compare and identify inaccuracies where they needed to re-measure.

Year 5 and 6

This week we have started writing our adventure stories. We have looked at how we can create an atmosphere or mood within our writing in order to engage the reader. In Geography, we have learnt about the oceans that surround the polar regions. We have analysed how they differ from the world's other oceans. In music, we have been learning how to relate positions on the ukulele fretboard to music notation.
