Reception

Slimy slithery snails have been everywhere in Reception this week.

The children went on a snail hunt and made some super snail soup (chopped up lettuce) to feed their snails, so they could observe them. In maths, they have learning about 2D shapes and studied the collage 'Snail' by Matisse, they then created their own snail collages using squares.





Year 1 and 2

In writing, we have been completing our Victorian school day diary and have spent some time carefully writing them up neatly. Next week, we're moving onto letter writing. In history, we found out about the Boscastle flood; the children learnt about how the cause of the flood, the damage caused and the role of the emergency services. The children

Year 5 and 6


