Class 1

In maths, we have been consolidating our knowledge of the bus stop method in the division unit. We had a great time testing the thermal properties of different materials in science. We managed to record three different data sets and we are ready to evaluate them next week. We have looked at shooting techniques in basketball and tried to implement them into a game situation.
