This week's class news

Class 1

In writing this week, Class 1 went on a senses walk as inspiration for a poem about what Spring is like to them. We hope you enjoy their final draft, which they have brought home. Their learning in maths has been deepening their understanding of measure, using metre sticks to measure objects and compare length and height, while Reception have been rotating,



manipulating and composing shapes to make Easter pictures and solve shape problems. Children have been learning about Easter and did some sewing to make an Easter egg pouch and also explored simple mechanisms to make a hinged Easter card. Class 1's seeds are now all planted and we are excited to see them beginning to shoot, while the caterpillars transformation has begun as they are beginning to form a chrysalis – I will add photos of them over the Easter holidays to see how they change and metamorphose.



Class 2

This week in English, the children worked hard to finish their visitor information board all about Boscastle. The final part of the project was researching the History of Boscastle, this included the flood in 2004, the history of Boscastle School, Minster Church and the history of the harbour. Outside, the children displayed their finished projects. In maths this week, Class 2 finished the unit on Length and Perimeter. The children worked hard to crack the code in an Easter themed maths



activity. After the Easter break, we will be moving on to learning about fractions. In PE this week we had a one-off lesson on dodgeball. We learnt the rules to 'ultimate dodgeball' and enjoyed lots of tournaments!

This week we have been writing a recount about our fabulous trip last Friday. We sequenced events and used time conjunctions in order to structure our work. In maths, we have been looking at fractions, decimals and percentages. We have also been continuing with 99 club after lunch and our progress through the colours has been fantastic. During our ukulele lesson, we went outside into the playground and used our knowledge of chords to write our own songs. We then recorded them on the iPad. We have also watched

film version of The Secret Garden and compared it to the book.
